What's happening: On behalf of West Northamptonshire Council, Kier Highways will soon be undertaking essential carriageway strengthening works on Stoke Road. This is to ensure the structural stability of the carriageway and stabilise the adjacent embankment. The works will also include some carriageway resurfacing and installation of vehicle restraint barrier.

Where: Stoke Road, Blisworth.

When: Monday 15th April – Friday 5th July 2024

Times: 24/7 Closure. Working hours Monday – Saturday 08:00 – 17:00.

How long: 12 Weeks

Traffic Management: A road closure will be in place on Stoke Road, Blisworth between Knock Lane and Greenside with an approved diversion route. Please do not park on the carriageway during these works. We reserve the right to tow away any vehicles restricting the works.

Residents: Vehicle access will be limited for residents. Residents with properties within the road closure will be escorted through by our traffic management contractors.

Emergency Vehicles: We aim to maintain access for emergency vehicles where safe to do so.




