- There is no plan to stop providing hard copy planning consultation documentation by a set date. SNC are encouraging accepting all documentation electronically by offering support.
- The grant scheme has not been ringfenced. Providing that the grant scheme is still running, the grant can be applied for at a later date. The benefit of applying for the grant now is that SNC are offering support through the process by identifying suitable equipment/an appropriate supplier and training.
